In June 1811, Thomas Bemus was granted a license to operate a ferry from Bemus Point to Stow. The ferry has been in operation almost continuously since then. The ferry was saved from destruction in 1982 and is run by a non-profit group of volunteers.

The Bicentennial event will include antique boats, cars and motorcycles, an historical baseball game, ice cream, a dedication, and of course, ferry rides.
