The Marion Labar Walford Water Wheel Overlook Building (in photo) is a unique visitor center built in 2004 to honor the history of the original dam & mill built in 1815 by Alexander Findley, founder of the town. The dam created Findley Lake.

The historical society holds a wealth of information & artifacts about the community, including Lakeside Assembly, a Chautauqua Institution-like program held on Findley Lake from 1895-1915. The Society is restoring a historic log cabin constructed in Canadian military style.
