Our local chapter was named after French Creek because of the prominent role that body of water played in colonial history. Six buildings have been removed from their original sites to the village common, including the Peter Ripley house, which depicts life in Sherman in 1860; Ray Larson's general store, which shows the period of 1900; and the buggy shed which



houses antiques and artifacts from 1800-1900; the Yorker Chapel which was originally a general store, the Nettle Hill School and a structure purportedly built by the French.
